As the holiday season approaches, it's worth the drive to Milton to take in their 8th annual "On the Way to Bethlehem" nativity pageant Nov. 27th - Nov.30th. More than 30,000 visitors from far and near have enjoyed this pageant to date, many making it a yearly tradition.

What makes this pageant unique? It occurs outdoors along the rural pathways and centuries old buildings of Country Heritage Park in Milton. The setting is so realistic it's easy to feel you are right there in the manger with Mary & Joseph. The pageant is also interactive with visitors being able to converse with the Roman soldiers, knock on the door of the inn or sing with the angels. And the children can get up close and personal with the many live animals – from sheep and goats to miniature ponies and donkeys to a real llama & camel.

Before you begin your guided journey to Bethlehem, enjoy the beautiful music of the massed choir in the large Gambrel Barn and at the conclusion there are refreshments and a tractor-drawn wagon ride to the exit.

The pageant runs each evening from 6:30 to 9:00 pm at Country Heritage Park, 8560 Tremaine Road, Milton. Admission is \$5:00 for adults, children free.
